Lynn gave an update from Mark on the entrance cameras. Relay Systems will provide a quarterly service for \$345. Mark will try to get competitive pricing.
We need to proceed with having Relay Systems repair the broken camera.

Lynn provided an update on speed bumps. A speed study will be required for the city to approve and install (for a charge-these aren't free).
To proceed with this, someone on the Board will need to take on this effort.

The sunshine committee is falling behind for Centennial (not the Reserve/Fairways). Jeannie volunteered to contact those currently owning this and see if they want to continue, or let someone else take this on.

Nikki gave an update on talking to Hal about the covenants. She hasn't had a chance to touch base with him yet.

An update was given on the neighborhood social/outdoor movie for July 11. Sunderlin Park will also be invited to attend.

An update was given by Michael about moving the brick column and iron fence at the entrance of Bay Hill and Hogan. It was decided to remove (not move) the brick column and connect the fence. The flower beds will not required to be moved.
