

CVNA Annual Meeting Minutes

August 6, 2015

President David Smith welcomed about 75 members of the Centennial Valley Neighborhood Association and provided an agenda for the meeting, Accomplishments during the 2014-15 year, and biographies of Board candidates. Nancy Dornblazer asked about getting more access stripes to speed-bumps painted, and LaTresha Woodruff responded with explanation of process during which city prioritizes projects.
